

Health Services provided at our District

- Reproductive and Child health services (e.g. ANC, breast lump and cervical cancer screening, Family Planning and immunization services)
- TB/HIV Services
- Basic and Emergency Obstetric and Surgical care
- Malaria prevention and Treatment
- Care and treatment services for people living with HIV/AIDS
- Eye and dental services
- Physiotherapy

Achievements

- Reduction of deaths due to Malaria among under five children from 22.3% in 2010 to 1.3% death in 2015
- Reduction of deaths due to TB from 10% in 2010 to 4% in 2015 (National target is <4%)
- Reduction of Maternal mortality rate from 132/100000 in 2010 to 104/10000 in 2015
- Reduction of children under five deaths from 5/1000 in 2010 to 3/1000 in 2015
- Reduction in prevalence of HIV/AIDS/STI from 4% in 2010 to 1.6% in 2015
- Construction of major theatre with two operating rooms
- Establishment of neonatal care unit
- Procurement of modern ultra sound, ECG and patient monitor

Challenges

- Hospital has few buildings and some of them are very small compared to total number of patients attended, such as offices, out patients departments rooms, surgical and private wards, mortuary physiotherapy unit. Through inadequate infrastructure we lack special wards like maternity waiting room, orthopedics / trauma wards and intensive care unit.
- Inadequate specialized medical supplies and equipment
- Inadequate skills of staff in neonatal care
- Inadequate skills of staff in managing orthopedic and trauma cares

- Government support
- Recruitment permit (government regulation)
- Private public partnership
- Donors support
- Community support

Way forward

- To continue request support from central government, NGOs and other stake holders For construction of Surgical wards, ICU, OPD and mortuary
- To recruit more health care providers according to government policy
- To procure medicines and equipment which are out of stock at MSD by using NHIF, CHF and cost sharing funds.
